AM I ELIGIBLE?

- You must have permission to work in the US.
- You must be enrolled in a Troy Continuing Education class.
- You must be ready to search for and start a job after completing the TRAC program.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Complete the TRAC application. Applications are available in March. The TRAC Program starts in July and finishes in 1 year.
- If you are eligible, you will receive an email with a date and time for a TRAC orientation. You must attend
 a TRAC orientation to learn more information.
- At the TRAC orientation you will schedule a meeting to interview with the TRAC instructors to help the

instructors learn more about you and your career goals.
