Oakland Literacy student *Bernadette* knows what it means to have to take a step back ... Growing up in Pontiac, Bernadette recalls being "smart as a whip" and her father's pride in her academics. But at just 15 years of age, Bernadette made a difficult decision. Her nieces and nephews needed her. Just one year shy of graduation, Bernadette dropped out of high school to care for the children. She went on to join the workforce.

Yet Bernadette's love for learning never faltered. She never lost sight of her goal to earn her GED. Bernadette found Oakland Literacy Council and was paired with tutor Rachel, a recent college graduate from Naperville, Illinois. Rachel's family comes from Pontiac, just like Bernadette.

Bernadette graduated from the reading program at Oakland Literacy in 2021. Besides getting one step closer to her GED, she is learning how to build up her credit – to one day own a home.

#### Math was a big step forward for Oakland Literacy Council, too.


Did you know there are over 250,000 adults in Oakland County who lack basic math skills? (PIACC, 2019)

Lack of basic math skills is holding people back from getting into training programs and being successful in community college. We need to train more math tutors and match them with adults who are ready to move forward. To achieve this goal, we need funding so our new math coordinator, a PhD from Oakland University, can work full time. With your help, we can build better bridges to career and college readiness for our adult students.

Every week, over 200 tutor-student pairs are meeting virtually to build reading, writing, English-speaking, and math skills.

Adults who once thought reading was out of reach are moving forward. This time last year we introduced you to *Cornelius*, a full-time working father of two who never had a chance to go to school.

Cornelius and his tutor,
Kim, have been using the Barton
curriculum for adults who may
have learning disabilities. With this
multi-sensory program, Cornelius
is finally breaking the code of
phonics, the essential building
blocks of reading. His confidence
and pride are growing. Today, he
can read his daughter a bedtime
story. Cornelius now says,

And when you give, you are not just helping our adult learners. You are making our community stronger. Stronger because of students like *Brenda*.


An immigrant from Mexico, Brenda wants to improve her English to become a citizen. At work, she helps other immigrants thrive in the United States.
